6. What other skills and experience are you able to bring to this post? E.g. computer skills, music, drama etc, experience in leadership and public speaking. Include any vocational qualifications or training you have undertaken.
7. What does Discipleship of young people mean to you?
8. How have you provided opportunities for young people to hear about Jesus?
9. Describe about any work you have done with young people. What have you done, how did you enjoy it, what skills have you developed and what have you learned.
10. What do you think are the issues for young people graduating from the youth group at 18?
11. A parent comes to you and says their 14 year old does not want to come to church.
12. What are the issues? How would you approach them?
13. You are asked by a school to give an RE lesson on Christianity and Evolution. This class includes members of the church youth group. How would you approach this?
14. Two boys in the youth group kick off and end up exchanging blows. Both have superficial injuries. What are the issues? How would you approach them?
15. Two church parents use the opportunity of the Friday night club to go out for the evening and are frequently the last to pick up their 11 & 13 year old children. What do you do?
