What do we do here?

All-together Service is held on the first Sunday of every month and is where all of us can join together to hear the Word of God and then worship Him through communion and song.

Communion Service is an open time of worship when any believer can contribute with their expressions of praise and adoration. At some point during the service we take the bread and wine as a way of helping us to remember our Lord Jesus.

Morning Worship is a service for those from every age group to enjoy. A relaxing time after the week gone by and a refreshing way to start the new week, with worship and clear Bible teaching.

Sunday Evenings have occasional special events.

Can I take Communion?

Romans 10:9 "If you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord', and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

Hebron church invites all Christians to whom this verse applies, and who are in good standing with their fellow believers, to join with us in taking the bread and wine. In Communion we remember Jesus' death and look forward to His return as we celebrate our unity in Him.
