



## Re-starting Kidzone

But we have missed being together, so we are looking forward to resuming some Kidzone sessions in the Hebron building together.

Obviously things are a little bit different from when we last met, so what should you expect when you come along? Here are some things to help you.....

### Coming and going

- Kidzone will be at a different time and a little bit shorter – to allow us to clean up after and for you to get home in time to watch the 11am livestream. The new time is **9.30 – 10.15am**.
- Entrance to the building will be through the Crown Street door. Hand sanitiser will be available at the entrance and all must use this before moving on to the Kidzone room.
- Parents can take their children to the entrance of the Kidzone room if they so wish, but you cannot stay I'm afraid (unless you are one of the session volunteers).
- We are operating a one way system, so if parents are in the building the exit is via the café on to Botchergate.
- Remember to firmly shut the café exit door when you leave – sometimes it pops open again.
- All adults must wear masks in the building.
- At the end of the session children will exit the building through the café door. To limit the amount of people in the building we ask that parents wait outside on Botchergate and we will bring your child to you. Please observe social distancing guidelines even as you wait outside.
- Children will sanitise their hands before leaving.

### In the session

- We'll try and have lots of the usual Kidzone items when we are together – prayer, games, stories, crafts, videos.
- There will be no singing, but we will show some songs to help us all worship and learn.
- When there are crafts, we will limit any sharing of resources between the children and try to give each of them their own craft pack.
- Social distancing guidelines apply, so children will be 2 metres apart wherever possible – although those from the same households can bubble together.
- Children under 11 do not need to wear masks or face coverings – but if they want to be a superhero and put on their favourite mask we won't say no.

### **More important stuff**

- Please do not attend if you or a member of your household has any coronavirus symptoms (a temperature or continuous cough or loss of taste or smell) or are awaiting a result of a test, or have been asked to self-isolate.
- Spaces in Kidzone may be limited, so we ask that you let us know if your child is able and wanting to come along. This will help us greatly. We ask that you let us know by the Thursday before the Kidzone session – don't worry, we'll send a reminder.
- If you can't come for some reason, let us know as soon as possible in case it frees up a space for someone else.
- We will keep a register and all who attend the session for Track and Trace purposes.

Finally, thanks for your patience and understanding as we try get these session up and running again in the safest possible way.
